DAY 2: Back-to-back course racing in Zeally Bay, Torquay.

The Coaster Race has been a signal feature of the Torquay Sailing Club's calendar for many years. Traditionally it has been only for catamarans but in 2020 we are opening up the race to include mono-hulled boats.

NOTE:

For Mono hulls there is a yard stick requirement: Mono hulls with a yardstick under 120 can participate in both directions for the coaster; for those with a yardstick between 120 and 145 only the return leg from Point Roadknight to Torquay will be permitted. Boats with a yardstick of greater than 145 will be unable to enter.

Race Briefing

The briefing for the Coaster will take place at 10.30 am on 25th January for a noon start. As safety on the water is the pre-eminent consideration it is important to note that the coaster will only take place under suitable and safe weather conditions. In the event of adverse conditions the coaster will be postponed to the Sunday.

Catering

Breakfast can be purchased at the Torquay Sailing Club on both days of the Regatta.

A BBQ lunch and drinks will be available for purchase at the Anglesea Club at the end of the first leg of the coaster.

A celebratory dinner will be held at the Torquay Sailing Club on Saturday evening – tickets can be purchased on-line for this rip roaring event!!

Course Racing in Zeally Bay

The second day's activity will consist of back-to-back course racing. The precise course will depend on weather conditions and be open to all boat classes .
